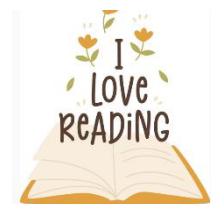

### Hedgehog Class Assembly

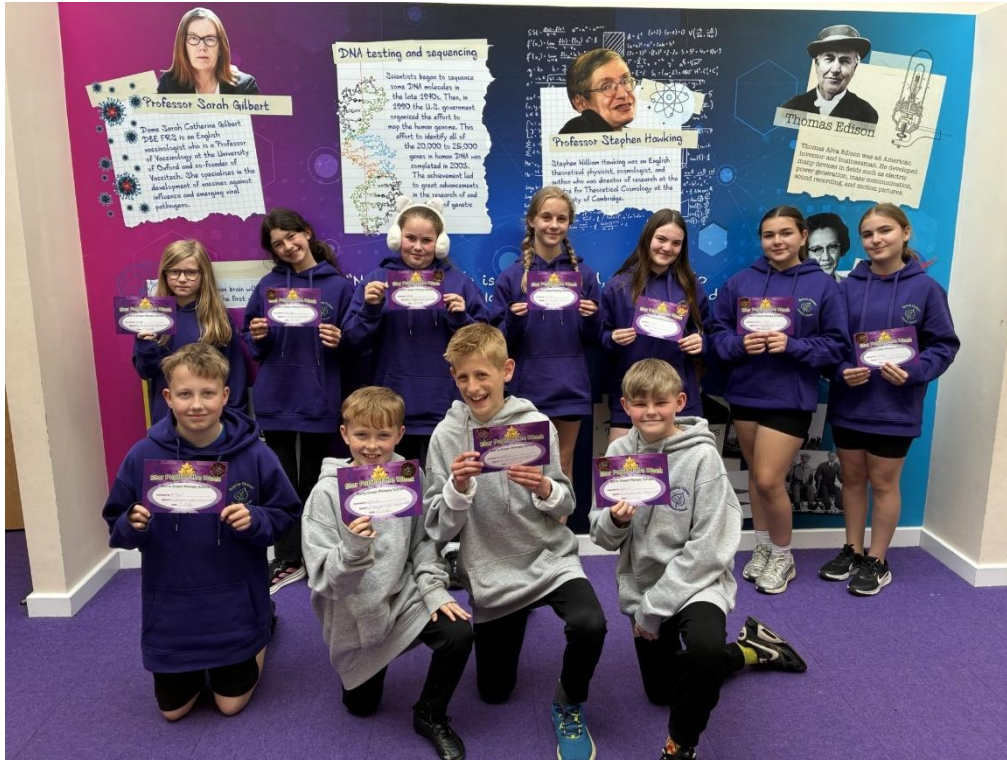
I was sad to miss Hedgehog Class assembly on Wednesday due to a prior commitment however well done to all of those who took part, learning lines and speaking with confidence.
