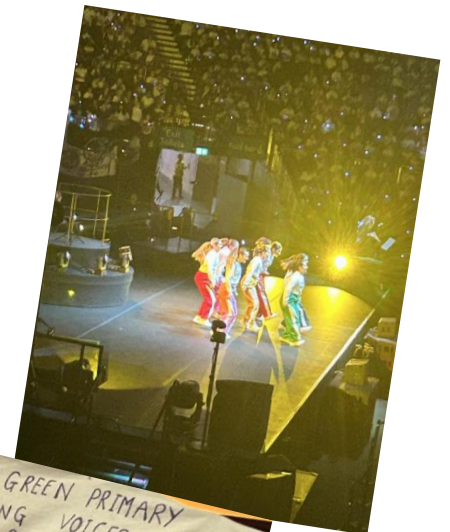
We arrived home at 11:30pm after a diversion on the way and definitely slept well. I however woke with 'The Power in Me' still ringing through my ears!!

Have a good weekend.

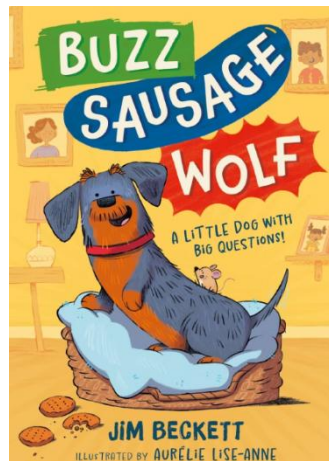
