You will have noted that we are shutting the school gates, including the car park gates during the school day. The safety and wellbeing of children and staff is in the forefront of our minds here and it brings the school in line with other schools.

We will monitor the impact of closing the footpath gates and review this in due course.

You will also note that we are in the process of installing CCTV to cover the school office / lobby area and the staff carpark. We will publish the CCTV policy on the school website and send parents a link to this when it goes live.

None of these changes impacts upon the experience of the children here. Once again, this week visitors have noted the calm and productive atmosphere within the school. Visitors comment upon the skill and expertise of staff and County are increasingly noting our good practice and asking us to support colleagues from other schools. Whilst we are pleased to be in such a position our priority continues to be the children here and of course the whole Barns Green community.
