Learning	Communication	Behaviour
<p><i>School will;</i> Inform parents about their child's learning. Ensure that every child is taught at a level appropriate to their individual needs. Maintain an attractive environment with good materials and equipment. Deliver education in line with the National Curriculum.</p> <p><i>Home will;</i> Encourage our child to participate fully in school activities. Support our child's learning by attending parent's meetings and performances. Encourage our child to take every opportunity to learn both at school and at home. Ensure our child is fully equipped for the days lessons e.g PE kit, instruments, Pencil case (KS2)</p> <p><i>Pupil will;</i> Try my best at all times.</p>	<p><i>School will;</i> Give full and clear information about your child's progress and development needs. Communicate regularly with parents about school life. Be available to discuss any matters with parents. Model positive relationships.</p> <p><i>Home will;</i> Make sure the school always has emergency contact information. Raise any concerns about school as soon as possible. Attend consultation days. Model positive relationships.</p> <p><i>Pupil will;</i> Remember to give my family any school letters.</p>	<p><i>School will;</i> Make sure children are familiar with and understand school rules. Ensure all members of staff set a high standard of personal behaviour. Recognise and reward positive behaviour and use sanctions fairly. Keep parents informed about their child's behaviour.</p> <p><i>Home will;</i> Help our child understand and follow school rules. Support the school in promoting and modelling positive behaviour. Notify the school promptly of any matter which may affect our child's behaviour at school.</p> <p><i>Pupil will;</i> Always try to behave well and follow the school rules. Be polite and treat everybody with respect.</p>

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Attendance	Homework	Safety and Welfare
<p><i>School will;</i> Start and finish classes promptly. Maintain and monitor an accurate record of attendance. Make every effort to communicate directly with parents on the first day of un-notified absence.</p> <p><i>Home will;</i> Make sure our child is at school regularly and on time. Contact the school promptly on the first day of absence. Make sure our child is collected promptly.</p> <p><i>Pupil will;</i> Get up on time to get to school</p>	<p><i>School will;</i> Set appropriate homework. Give children feedback on their homework. Set take away tasks for children to work on at home.</p> <p><i>Home will;</i> Read to and with our child frequently. Help our child complete their homework on time. Ensure school property is looked after when at home. Support our child in completing take away tasks.</p> <p><i>Pupil will;</i> Complete my homework on time and bring it into school on the right day.</p>	<p><i>School will;</i> Ensure children can work in a safe, orderly and caring environment. Ensure that bullying, racist or other discriminatory behaviour is not tolerated Treat every child as a valued individual. Ensure that the County Council Safeguarding Children procedures are followed.</p> <p><i>Home will;</i> Teach our child about personal hygiene. Help our child understand that everyone is of equal importance. Keep our child at home if they are unwell. Let the school know of any issues that may affect our child's welfare.</p> <p><i>Pupil will;</i> Walk inside the school buildings. Remember that every person is an important individual.</p>
