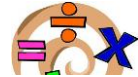


Maths

- **Number:** Division and fractions
Y1 – Place Value to 100
Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
Sharing and Grouping.
Fractions – a half and a quarter
- **Geometry** – position and direction
- **Time** – hour, half hour, hour, minutes and seconds, days of the week, months of the year.
- Y2 – Fractions – half, quarter, third
- **Time** – o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to. Tell the time to 5 minutes.
- **Statistics** – make tally charts, and interpret pictograms.
- **Measurement:** Length and Height, weight, capacity and temperature.
- **Position and Direction**
 - Regular maths H/W for Year 2 will be set each Monday and we will be focusing upon number bonds, division and the 2,5,10, 3 times tables for fluency.
